

## Division Descriptions

### **18" Beginning Jumper Division**

Open to all riders. Open to horses and ponies. Fences set at 18" in height with no oxers. Entries in this division may not enter any other jumper division at the same show, or any non-jumper division where fence heights exceed 2'.

### **2' Jumper Division**

Open to all riders. Open to horses and ponies. Fences set up to 2' in height with 2' to 2'6" spreads. An entry in this division may not enter any hunter or jumper division with fences over 2'3" in height.

### **2'3" Jumper Division**

Open to all riders. Open to horses and ponies. Fences set up to 2'3" in height with 2'3" to 2'9" spreads. An entry in this division may not enter any hunter or jumper division with fences over 2'6" in height.

### **2'6" Jumper Division**

Open to all riders. Open to horses and ponies. Fences set up to 2'3" in height with 2'3" to 2'9" spreads. An entry in this division may not enter any hunter or jumper division with fences over 2'9" in height.

### **MHSA Regional Open 2'6" Jumper Finals**

Open only by invitation to compete by The MHSA. Fences set at 2'6" in height with 2'6" to 3' spreads.

### **Thoroughbred Jumper (OTTB) 2'6" Division**

Open to all riders. Open to all Thoroughbreds who were in training for the track or who came off the track.

### **2'9" Jumper Division**

Open to all riders. Open to horses and ponies. Fences set up to 2'9" in height with 2'9" to 3'3" spreads. An entry in this division may not enter any hunter or jumper division with fences over 3' in height at the same show.

### **3' Jumper Division**

Open to all riders. Open to horses and ponies. Fences set up to 3' in height with 3' to 3'6" spreads.

### **MHSA Regional Children/Adult Amateur 3' Jumper Finals**

Open only by invitation to compete by The MHSA. Open to horses and ponies, shown by a Junior or Adult Amateur rider with a current MHSA membership. Fences set at 3' in height with 3' to 3'6" spreads.

### **3' 3" - 3'6" Jumper Division**

Open to all riders. Open to horses and ponies. Fences set at 3'3" in height with 3'3" to 3'9" spreads.

### **BEST Costume Hunter Classic - 18" or 2'**

Open to all riders on horses and ponies in their costume of choice. **This will be divided into two groups. The first group will be for riders competing in classes at this horse show at 18" jump heights. This round will be over a course of 4 or 5 fences.** The second group will complete a hunter round at 2'. Entry in these classes will not impact eligibility for any other class at this show. To be judged on performance and soundness with an additional bonus available for the costume of mount and/or rider. If at any time during the class a member of the show staff feels that the costume is unsafe to the horse/pony or rider they will be immediately excused from the ring. Ribbons will be awarded to 8th place and the winner will receive a Halloween themed prize.

### **BEST Costume Parade**

Open to all riders/handlers on horses and ponies. May be shown mounted or on a lead line depending on what works best with the costume. If mounted, a helmet must be worn and properly fastened. All entries must have a back number but if this is the only class entered there will be no additional Office Fee charged. **We will not hold the parade due to a conflict with another ring.** Ribbons will be awarded to 8th place and the winner will receive a Halloween themed prize.

## Rules and Regulations

- **Every class offered herein which is covered by the specifications and rules of the current MHSA Rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.**
- All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show manager whose decision shall be final.
- Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show.
- BEST Horse Shows, LLC, The MHSA and Prince George's Equestrian Center will assume no responsibility, nor is liable for any injury to person or horse at any time while on the show grounds. The MHSA, BEST Horse Shows, LLC and Prince George's Equestrian Center will not be responsible for lost or damaged items. All owners, exhibitors, and attendees will be held responsible for any damage incurred to them or their agent's properties on the show grounds.
- An Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) will be on the horse show grounds during all riding activities.
- The Farrier will be on site Saturday and Sunday during the show.
- The phone number for the on-call veterinarian will be on display in the show office.
- Prior to the show weekend, information for the horse show can be found on the web at **www.besthorseshow.com** or **www.horseshowing.com**. During the show, the Horse Show Office and Show Secretary can be contacted at **301-952-7934**.
- Faxed entries will be accepted at: 410-867-7923.
- Riders must wear a ASTM/SEI certified helmet at all times when mounted.
- To meet Maryland Coggin's test requirements, an exhibitor must provide a negative Coggin's test dated within one year of the competition dates of the show. Any horse not in compliance will be asked to leave the show grounds. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to make sure the Coggins is submitted with their entry forms.
- Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to the competition. Any horse not in compliance will be asked to leave the show grounds. (USEF GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule).
- **No dogs are permitted in the Show Place Arena.** All dogs on the outdoor show grounds must be on a leash, no longer than 6 feet and attached to a human. **No dogs are permitted in the show rings during schooling.** Owners of free-running or unattended dogs will be fined \$50.
- Food and beverages will be available on the show grounds. Please be advised that no alcoholic beverages in any form may be brought onto the show grounds.
- Owners of all ponies must possess a valid measurement card or a copy of a valid measurement form to be presented to the Show Secretary.
- Stall Fee: \$75. Stall reservations must be made with Jamie Suchoski via text message to 410-340-5793 or emailed to besthorseshow@gmail.com. Stalls will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- All non-stabled horses are required to pay a grounds fee of \$20. All animal waste must be disposed of in the manure pits provided at PGECC. Please do not muck your trailer out onto the parking or grassy areas. Violators will be charged for cleanup.
- Bedding can be pre-ordered by contacting Jamie Suchoski via text to 410-340-5793 or at besthorseshow@gmail.com. Exhibitors also have the option of bringing their own bedding to the show.
- Camper spaces are \$50 and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Electric hookup is included. Camper spaces are available from Friday morning until the conclusion of the show on Sunday. Anyone moving a camper into a space prior to Friday, or staying past Sunday, will be assessed an additional fee of \$30 per day.
- Golf cart rentals are available from United Metro Golf Carts. To make a reservation, call 1-800-772-6776. Reservations must be made prior to the show so that carts can be delivered on Friday. On-site rental of golf carts will not be available. Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate any motorized vehicle on the show grounds!

**\$500 MHA Thoroughbred Hunter Classic.** Open by invitation only from The MHA. The second over fences round of the MHA Thoroughbred Hunter (202) will count as the first round score for the Thoroughbred Classic. Class 204 will count as the second round of the Thoroughbred Classic. The \$500 purse will be distributed as follows:

1st - \$165, 2nd - \$110, 3rd - \$75, 4th - \$60, 5th - \$50, 6th - \$40

### **BEST \$1,000 Derby Style Hunter Classics**

**These Classics are not MHA rated.** Each entry must compete in at least one entire Hunter division to enter a Classic. Riders may enter as many mounts as desired in the first round of a classic, but may only ride two for any one of the Classics' second rounds. The rider for the second round of the classic must be the same rider as the first round. Horses must jump the same height in the second round of the classic as they jumped in the first round. If a horse or pony is entered in more than one "first round" class for any of the Classics, then one division must be declared as the "first round" of the Classic at the time of show registration. Only the top 20 first round scores will qualify for each Classic. Individual Classics may be cancelled if less than eight horses are entered. Once entered, Classics may not be cancelled once the first-round trip has been ridden, even if an entry doesn't qualify for the second round.

Prize money for each of the Classics will be awarded as follows:

1st - \$450, 2nd - \$225, 3rd - \$125, 4th - \$75, 5th - \$50, 6th - \$25, 7th - \$25, 8th - \$25

### **\$1,000 Pony Derby Style Hunter Classic**

Open to ponies shown by a junior rider. The following over fence classes will count as the first round of the BEST Pony Hunter Classic: 351 (2'), 353 (2'3"), and 355 (2'6"). The second round of the Classic will be the "Derby Style" round. Each Round will count as 50% of the total Classic score. Fences set at 2', 2'3", and 2'6", with bonus option fences set up to 3" higher.

### **\$1,000 Low Junior / Adult Amateur Derby Style Hunter Classic**

Open to horses or ponies shown by a junior or adult amateur rider. The following over fence classes will count as the first round of the BEST Low Junior / Adult Amateur Hunter Classic: 352 (2') and 354 (2'3"). The second round of the Classic will be the "Derby Style" round. Each Round will count as 50% of the total Classic score. Fences set at 2' and 2'3", with bonus option fences set at up to 3" higher.

### **\$1,000 High Junior / Adult Amateur Derby Style Hunter Classic**

Open to horses shown by a junior or adult amateur riders. The following over fence classes will count as the first round of the BEST Low Junior / Adult Amateur Hunter Classic: 356 (2'6") and 358 (3'). The second round of the Classic will be the "Derby Style" round. Each Round will count as 50% of the total Classic score. Fences set at 2'6" and 3', with bonus option fences set at up to 3" higher.

### **\$1,000 High Open Derby Style Hunter Classic**

Open to all riders on horses. All professional riders may only ride in this Classic. The following over fence classes will count as the first round of the BEST High Open Hunter Classic: 357 (2'6") and 359 (3'). The second round of the Classic will be the "Derby Style" round. Each Round will count as 50% of the total Classic score. Fences set at 2'6", 2'9" and 3', with bonus option fences set at up to 3" higher.

### **MHA Regional Program Finals**

All MHA Divisions are closed to invitation only. Letters of invitation for the MHA Regional Championship Horse Show will be e-mailed after the qualifying period has ended.

Approximately the top 20 horses / riders in each division, will be invited. To be eligible a horse/pony/rider must have shown at least two MHA Regional Horse Shows, between the qualifying period of December 1, 2021 - October 23, 2022, and earned points in the division they would like to enter at the Championship horse show.

The same horse/pony and rider combination that competes at any of the fall indoor shows such as Pennsylvania National, Washington International (Exception Local Hunters) or The National Horse Show is not eligible to compete at the MHA Regional Championship Horse Show.

Riders will be given seven days to accept the invitation. If invitations are not accepted, additional horses / riders will be invited.

### **Show Prizes/Points**

Ribbons will be awarded to eight places for each class, plus Division Champion and Reserve Champion. All MHA Regional Finals Classes are double pointed toward MHA year-end standings. Each horse/rider will receive double MHA points for each individual class placing. All classes not MHA rated will be awarded to eight places, plus Division Champion and Reserve. No class at this horse show counts toward 2022 BEST Horse Show Series Year-end standings.

Class points are awarded as follows:

1st - 10, 2nd - 6, 3rd - 4, 4th - 3, 5th - 2, 6th - 1.5, 7th - 1, 8th - .5

### **Ties for Championships and Reserves**

In the Hunter Divisions, the Championship will be awarded to the animal with the highest number of points in the Over Fences Classes. If a tie still exists, then dual Championships will be awarded.

### **Scratches**

Scratching classes or divisions may only be done in the Horse Show Office. Once a class begins, it may not be scratched. There is no charge for scratching classes or divisions. A horse scratched from a show prior to the start of the first class entered, will forfeit office fees for the show.

## Division Descriptions

### 3' Schooling Hunter Division

Open to all riders. Open to all horses and ponies. Entries may not enter any other classes where fence heights below 2'6". Fences set at 3'.

### BEST Pony Hunter Division

Open to riders 17 & under as of Dec. 1st of the previous year. Open to all ponies. Riders in this division may not show in other divisions where fence heights exceed 2'6" at any show. Fences set at 2', 2'3", or 2'6". Oxers to be used.

### 2'6" Open Hunter Division

Open to all riders. Open to all horses and ponies. Entries may not enter any other classes where fence heights exceed 2'9". Fences set at 2'6".

### 3' Open Hunter Division

Open to all riders. Open to all horses and ponies. Entries may not enter any other classes where fence heights below 2'6". Fences set at 3'.

### BEST Mini Stirrup Pleasure Division

Open to riders 10 and under as of Dec 1st of the previous year. This division is intended for riders who only show at the walk and trot. Riders may not enter any class requiring a canter.

### BEST Junior Equitation Walk/Trot Division

Open to riders 17 and under as of Dec 1st of the previous year. This division is intended for riders who only show at the walk and trot.

### BEST Junior Pleasure Division

Open to riders 17 and under as of Dec 1st of the previous year. Classes offered are walk/trot, walk/trot/canter, and over cross-rails.

### BEST Senior English Pleasure Division

Open to horses or ponies. Open to adult amateur riders 18 and older as of Dec 1st of the previous year. Fences set at 18". No oxers may be used. Horse/rider combination may not enter any other classes where fences exceed 2' at the same show.

### BEST Open Equitation Division

Open to horses or ponies. Open to all riders. Fences set at 18". No oxers may be used. Horse/rider combination may not enter any other classes where fences exceed 2' at the same show.

### MHSA Low Children's Hunt Seat Equitation Medal Finals

Open to junior exhibitors that have not reached 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year on a horse. The class shall be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control throughout over eight or more fences. The course must contain an oxer, at least one change of direction and two of the following which may not be combined: a bending line, a narrow jump (8'), a roll back turn, a fence at the end of the ring, or a long approach to a single fence. Fence height shall be 2'6". The judges will then select at least one fourth of the class, but not less than six riders, if available, to show at a walk, trot and canter. The same horse must be shown in all phases of the class. Martingales are prohibited in the flat phase. Riders may not compete in classes where fences exceed 2'6" at the same show. In addition the judges must require at least 4 riders to perform additional tests. The judges may select any tests, 1 to 19.

### MHSA Low Adult Amateur Hunt Seat Equitation Medal Finals

Open to senior amateur members of the MHSA. The class shall be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control throughout over eight or more fences. The course must contain an oxer, at least one change of direction and two of the following which may not be contained: a bending line, a narrow jump (8'), a roll back turn, a fence at the end of the ring, or a long approach to a single fence. Fence height shall be 2'6". The judges will then select at least one fourth of the class, but not less than six riders, if available, to show at a walk, trot and canter. The same horse must be shown in all phases of the class. Martingales are prohibited in the flat phase. Riders may not compete in classes where fences exceed 2'6" at the same show. In addition the judges must require at least 4 riders to perform additional tests. The judges may select any tests, 1 to 19.

## Division Descriptions

---

**MHSA Pleasure Horse and Pleasure Pony.** Horses and ponies shall be of any breed or combination of breeds suitable for English riding and normally used for pleasure. To be shown under English tack. Martingales are prohibited. Good manners are essential both in executing the gaits and while lined up in the ring. All horses and ponies must be serviceably sound. In the English Pleasure Division, all animals over 14.2 hands are horses and all animals under 14.2 hands and under are ponies. Classes may be divided by horses and ponies. Horse and pony classes with less than three entries will be combined. Pony classes may be divided by height of ponies. Small/Medium ponies under 13.2 hands. Large ponies over 1.2 hands and not exceeding 14.2 hands. Ponies must have a current MHSA measurement card (if USEF card is not available) on file with MHSA office prior to showing in this division. Ponies must be ridden by and handled by junior exhibitors in all phases of a class. Junior exhibitors shall not have reached their 18th birthday. Stallions are barred from all classes limited to junior exhibitors. For the purposes of the pleasure division the term "suitability" shall mean suitability to purpose as a pleasure mount. Points for the pleasure division are awarded as follows: 5-3-2-1. Champion 10 points and Reserve Champion 6 points. In the event of a tie for champion, horses/ponies shall be hacked off. If one of the participants does not show up for the hack off, the participating horse/pony will be awarded the championship points.

### **MHSA Junior Equitation**

Open to horses and ponies ridden by junior exhibitor that have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st, 2021. To be scored 5-3-2-1. Junior Equitation may be split by age or by horse/pony. If split by age, it shall be split 13 & under and 14 – 17. To be judged equally on hands, seat, and control of mount and suitability to count. The over fences class fence heights shall be 2' 2'6", and 3'. The flat class to be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. At the judge's discretion, other tests may be performed. Maybe combined with the Adult Equitation if there are less than 4 entries.

### **MHSA Adult Equitation**

Open to horses and ponies ridden by amateur exhibitor who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st, 2021 and who are Senior Amateur members. Members competing in classes restricted to amateurs must meet the requirements of USEF RULE GR1306. Your signature as rider on the entry blank and annual membership form will verify that you understand and are in compliance with the rule. If split by age, it shall be split 18 – 35 and 36 and older. May be combined with Junior Equitation if there are fewer than 4 entries. To be judged equally on hands, seat, control, and suitability of mount. The fence heights for the over fences class shall be 2'6" and 3'. The flat class is to be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. Additional tests may be required.

### **Green Hunter Division**

Open to Horses and Ponies in their first or second year of showing over "Hunter Style" fences. Horses may not enter any other classes where fence heights exceed 2'3" at the same show. Fences set at 2'. No oxers may be used. Once a horse has won a "Year-end" Championship in a green hunter division, it is ineligible to compete in a green hunter division in the future.

### **Adult Amateur Hunter Division**

Open to adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Fences set at 2' and 2'3". Entries may not enter any classes at the same show where fences are higher than the height option they are jumping in this division.

### **Junior Hunter Horse Division**

Open to riders 17 & under as of Dec. 1st of the previous year. Open to all horses. Fences set at 2' or 2'3".

### **2'6" Schooling Hunter Division**

Open to all riders. Open to all horses and ponies. Entries may not enter any other classes where fence heights exceed 2'9". Fences set at 2'6".

### Division Descriptions

#### MHSA Low Hunter

Open to horses. Fence height shall be 2'6" and 2'9". Spreads not to exceed the height of the fences. To be judged on performance and soundness.

#### MHSA Working Hunter

Open to horses. Fence height shall be 3' and 3'3". Spreads not to exceed the fence height. To be judged on performance and soundness. Course shall consist of no less than eight fences.

MHSA Thoroughbred Hunter. Open to horses that are registered with or are eligible to be registered with The Jockey Club. To be judged on performance and soundness. Fences to be 2'6" and 3'. Spreads not to exceed fence height.

#### MHSA Short Stirrup Hunter

Open to ponies ridden by a junior exhibitor who have not reached their 11 h birthday by December 1st, 2021. A rider may not cross enter into any other MHSA Regional hunter, pleasure, or equitation division or class, except Short Stirrup Equitation. In addition, riders may not compete in any jumper classes or classes where the height exceeds 18". Stallions are barred from all classes. A course should consist of a minimum of 4 fences and a maximum of 8 fences. No oxers may be used. Fences shall be 18". Spreads not to exceed height of fence. To be judged on performance, soundness, and suitability of mount.

#### MHSA Short Stirrup Equitation

Open to ponies ridden by a junior exhibitor who have not reached their 11 th birthday by December 1st, 2021. A rider may not cross enter into any other MHSA Regional hunter, pleasure, or equitation division or class, except Short Stirrup Hunter. In addition, riders may not compete in any jumper classes or classes where the height exceeds 18". Stallions are barred from all classes. No martingales allowed in under saddle classes. A course should consist of a minimum of 4 fences and a maximum of 8 fences. No oxers may be used. Fences shall be 18". Spreads not to exceed height of fence. To be judged equally on hands, seat, control of mount, and suitability of purpose. Points are counted 5-3-2-1 for 1st through 4th place..

#### MHSA Mini Stirrup Equitation

Open to ponies ridden by a junior exhibitor who have not reached their 11th birthday by December 1st, 2021. A rider may not cross enter into any other MHSA Regional division or class except Lead Line. Riders in this division may also not cross enter into any classes that involve cantering and/or jumping. Stallions shall be barred from all classes. No martingales allowed. Points are counted 5-3-2-1 for 1st through 4th place. To be judged on rider's hands, seat, guidance, control, and suitability of mount.

#### MHSA Long Stirrup Equitation

Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior exhibitor who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st, 2021 and adult amateur exhibitors. Senior Amateur exhibitors must meet the requirements of USEF Rule GR1306. Your signature as rider on the entry blank and annual membership form will verify that you understand and are in compliance with the rule. A rider may not cross enter into any other MHSA Regional hunter or equitation division or class, except Pleasure Horse and Pony, where permitted. In addition, riders may not compete in any jumper classes or classes where the height exceeds 2'. Stallions are barred from all classes. No martingales allowed in flat classes. A course should consist of a minimum of 4 fences and a maximum of 8 fences. No oxers may be used. Fences shall be 18" – 2'. Spreads not to exceed height of fence. To be judged equally on hands, seat, control of mount, and suitability of purpose. Points are counted 5- 3-2-1 for 1st through 4th place toward the Merit Award. Champion and reserve champion points do not count towards Merit Awards.

MHSA Lead Line. For children seven years of age and under on a pony. To be judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk. No martingales allowed. No minimum entry numbers are required for points earned in a Lead Line class to count toward a MHSA Lead Line Merit Award. Children in this class are eligible to complete in Mini Stirrup. Points are counted 5-3-2-1 for 1st through 4th place toward the Merit Award.

### MHSA Children's Hunter

Open to horses ridden by a junior exhibitor who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1st, 2021. To be judged on performance, soundness, and suitability of mount. Fence height shall be 3'. Spreads not to exceed fence height. The Adult Amateur and Children's Hunter division may be combined if there are fewer than four entries in either section.

### MHSA Adult Amateur

Open to horses ridden by an Adult Amateur exhibitor who have reached their 18th birthday by December 1st, 2021. Members competing in classes restricted to amateurs must meet the requirements of USEF Rule GR1306. Your signature as rider on the entry blank and annual membership form will verify that you understand and are in compliance with the rule. To be judged on performance, soundness, and suitability of mount. Fence height shall be 3'. Spreads not to exceed height of fence. The Adult Amateur and Children's Hunter divisions may be combined if there are fewer than four entries in either section.

### MHSA Low Children's Hunter Horse

Open to horses ridden by junior exhibitor who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1st, 2021. A rider in the Low Children's is not eligible to cross enter into any other divisions where the fences exceed 2'6" at the same show except age group equitation or medal classes. Fence height shall be 2'6". Spreads not to exceed the height of the fence. To be judged on performance, soundness, and suitability of mount. The Low Children's Hunter Horse division and Low Adult Hunter division may be combined if there are fewer than four entries in either section. If a rider in Low Children's cross enters into other division where multiple heights are offered, the rider may not jump higher than 2'6".

### MHSA Low Adult Hunter

Open to horses to be shown by an Adult Amateur exhibitor who have reached their 18th birthday by December 1st, 2021. Members competing in classes restricted to amateurs must meet the requirements of USEF RULE GR1306. Your signature as rider on the entry blank and annual membership form will verify that you understand and are in compliance with the rule. A rider in the Low Adult Hunter division is not eligible to cross enter in any other divisions where the fences exceed 2'6" at the same show except age group equitation or medal classes. Fence height shall be 2'6". Spreads not to exceed the height of the fence. To be judged on performance, soundness, and suitability of mount. The Low Children's Hunter Horse division and Low Adult Hunter division may be combined if there are fewer than four entries in either section. If a rider in Low Adult Hunters cross enters into other divisions where multiple heights are offered, the rider may not jump higher than 2'6".

### MHSA Small/Medium Pony Hunter

Open to ponies ridden by a junior exhibitor who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1st, 2021. To be judged on performance, soundness, and suitability of mount. Fence height shall be 2'. Spreads not to exceed fence height. The Small/Medium Pony Hunter may be combined with the Large Pony Hunter division if there are fewer than four entries in either section. Ponies must have a current MHSA measurement card (if USEF card is not available) on file with MHSA office prior to showing in this division.

### MHSA Large Pony Hunter

Open to ponies ridden by a junior exhibitor who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1st, 2021. To be judged on performance, soundness, and suitability of mount. Fence height shall be 2'6". Spreads not to exceed fence height. The Small/Medium Pony Hunter may be combined with the Large Pony Hunter division if there are fewer than four entries in either section. Ponies must have a current MHSA measurement card (if USEF card is not available) on file with MHSA office prior to showing in this division.

### MHSA Low Pony Hunter

Open to ponies ridden by a junior exhibitor who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1st, 2021. To be judged on performance, soundness, and suitability of mount. A rider in the Low Pony Hunter division is not eligible to cross enter in any other division where the fences exceed 2' at the same show except age group equitation or medal classes not to exceed 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into Small/Medium Pony Hunter or Large Pony Hunter at the same show. Fence height shall be 2'. Spreads not to exceed height of fence. No oxers may be used. Ponies must have a current MHSA measurement card (if USEF card is not available) on file with MHSA office prior to showing in this division.
